Subject: Minutes of 1999 Annual Cluster Meeting

1. The 1999 Annual Meeting of the Hunters Green Cluster Association was held on December 7 at the Reston Community Center. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Jim Allred, President. Thirty-eight homeowners attended.
2. The minutes of the 1998 Annual Meeting were read and approved.
3. Each of the Board members reported conditions and accomplishments in his or her respective area of responsibility.
4. Bill Holmes, Treasurer, presented the year 2000 budget. The budget, under which annual cluster dues would remain unchanged at \$700, was approved by the membership.
5. Board members reported the status of the seven Strategic Plan Infrastructure Improvement projects scheduled for completion in 1999. Four had been completed, a fifth was to be completed by the end of December, and two were deferred until the following year.
6. Election of Officers. Jim Allred, President, announced his retirement from the board. The Cluster presented him a plaque recognizing his leadership and many contributions during the 12 years he served as President. Additionally, Maureen Burns decided to leave the Board after completing two years of her three-year term. To fill the two Board vacancies, members elected Katharine Hunter to a three-year term and Simon Rakoff to a one-year term.
7. Following a brief open discussion period, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 10:30 p.m.
